



PIT STOP BETTING (“PSB”) - POLICY ON RESPONSIBLE GAMING POLICY (“RGP”)

Our approach to games is simple: we want players to have fun and have great chances to win whilst being entertained in the process. PSB RGP is quite simple, and mirrors that simple approach: we want plays to be a fun experience.

We have put specific policies and procedures in place to ensure that you enjoy placing plays with PSB and that, should you need help at any point, we are here for you.

At times, it may be that playing can cause problems and the fun stops. We would always encourage you to play responsibly, which means, KNOW YOUR LIMITS.

We encourage you to only play what you can afford to lose and avoid chasing losses. It is equally important to keep track of the time and amount you spend playing. Our app will allow to have a quick look at it anytime. Please remember that the app has been designed for you to have fun and being in control of your playing. Hence, we inserted maximum betting amounts and maximum account refilling limits.

However, If you feel that your play is to cover up your losses to your family, or find that playing is no longer a fun activity, then you may have a problem. We invite you to take some time off and if you can't, we recommend you should seek advice and help to that effect. Our Customer Service Team will be there to communicate with you and assist in identifying the best course of actions for you to decide what to do to readdress the situation.

We recommend that anyone who finds their playing is getting out of control, should reduce how much time and money they are spending on it. You can also reduce your deposit limit and your daily spend. For further information on how to do this, please contact our Customer Service Team.

Self-exclusion

If you feel that playing is taking over your life and getting too much, you have the option to self-exclude, which means that you stop playing altogether. Self-exclusion can range from 6 months to 5 years.

Notably, if you have opted for self-exclusion with any other gambling company, you will need to inform us and may not be allowed to play at PSB.
